

- Crown Street, Pavillion Hill and Constantine Road ; and  
 (ii) between 8 and 6 on certain sides of Pavillion Hill and Chapel Street ; and  
 (iii) between 8 and 6 for a longer period than 20 minutes return prohibited for 2 hours on a certain side of Segontium Terrace.

Exceptions will permit waiting for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods, taking in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage, and where necessary, in connection with the maintenance of the roads, the supply of gas, electricity or water and the exercise of local authority statutory powers and duties, and in certain circumstances where the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle.

(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that the Gwynedd County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

When this Order comes into effect you will not be allowed to leave your vehicle between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on the north side of Bridge Street from the access road to Fron Tywyn in an easterly direction for a distance of 52 metres.

#### GWYNEDD COUNTY COUNCIL

##### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

*The County of Gwynedd (Various Roads, Llandudno)  
(Prohibition of Waiting by Coaches) (Experimental) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that Gwynedd County Council by an Order made 14th November 1980 under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and all other powers them enabling have directed that the above-named Experimental Order shall continue in force until 31st May 1981.

There is no change in the effect of the Order which provides as follows:

- (a) The Order applies to any vehicle which is constructed or adapted to carry more than twelve passengers other than stage carriages, express carriages, school buses and work buses.
- (b) The Order makes it unlawful for any person to leave any such vehicle at any time in any of the roads or parts of roads specified in the Schedule.

The Council wish to study the effect of the measure for a further period of 6 months.

Exceptions will permit waiting:

- (a) Where necessary, in the exercise of statutory powers or duties of a Local Authority or Water Authority.
- (b) For police, fire-brigade or ambulance purposes.
- (c) In any case where the person in control of the vehicle
  - (i) is required by law to stop
  - (ii) is obliged to stop so as to prevent an accident ;
 or
  - (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control.
- (d) for so long as may be necessary to enable
  - (i) a person to board or alight from the vehicle
  - (ii) a person to load or unload any luggage from the vehicle
  - (iii) the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to any road or part of road specified in the Schedule
  - (iv) Full details are contained in the Order, a copy of which may be examined together with a map showing the restricted roads during normal business hours at:

(1) County Offices, Shirehall Street, Caernarfon, Gwynedd.

(2) The Public Library, Mostyn Street, Llandudno, Gwynedd.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 14th November 1980 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
