*The City Council of Liverpool (Off-Street Parking Places)
(No. 2) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 14th November 1980, the City Council of Liverpool under agency arrangements with the Merseyside County Council made the above-named Order under sections 31 (1), (2) and (4), 53 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as subsequently amended, to become operative on 1st December 1980, the effect of which will be to control the use of the parking places named in the Schedule to this Notice. The Schedule shows the method of charge, the maximum period of waiting and the scale of charges for each parking place. The parking places will be operative for 24 hours a day for all vehicles other than heavy vehicles, unless a notice at the parking place indicates a lesser period.

The Order specifies the conditions under which the parking

places may be used. Full details are contained in the Order which, together with a plan showing the location of the parking places and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the City Solicitor's Office, Legal and Parliamentary Section, Room 34, Municipal Buildings, Dale Street, Liverpool, between the hours of 8.45 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as subsequently amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 14th November 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
