

## BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Buckinghamshire County Council (Madeley Road, Aylesbury) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 19th November 1980 the Buckinghamshire County Council made the above-named Order under sections 1 (1), (2) (3) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 1st December 1980, is to provide for the variation of the Borough of Aylesbury (Prohibition of Waiting and One-Way Traffic) (General) Order 1974, by the omission of that length of Madeley Road, referred to in the Schedule hereto and which is referred to in Schedule 3 to that Order.

A copy of the Order together with a map showing the length of road concerned may be examined at:

County Hall, Aylesbury, during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 19th November 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

That length of Madeley Road which extends from its junction with Mandeville Road and continues to a point eight metres to the east of the rear access into Rivets Sports Ground.

## BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The Buckinghamshire County Council (St. George's Way, Wolverton) (One Way Traffic) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 19th November 1980 the Buckinghamshire County Council made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 1st December 1980, is to prohibit any vehicle proceeding along the loop at the southern end of St. George's Way, Wolverton (which is situated approximately 25 metres south-east of its junction with Green Lane) in a direction otherwise than clockwise.

Exemptions to the Order will permit the following:

- (1) building, industrial or demolition operations;
- (2) removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (3) enabling works to be carried out;
- (4) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

*The Buckinghamshire County Council (A413, World's End, Weston Turville) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1980.*

Notice is hereby given that on 19th November 1980 the Buckinghamshire County Council made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the Order, which will come into operation on 1st December 1980, is to prohibit any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. on any day in the lengths of road referred to in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions to the Order will permit:

- (1) Waiting with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden;
- (2) Waiting for so long as may be necessary: (a) for persons to board or alight; (b) for goods to be loaded or unloaded; (c) for enabling works to be carried out; (d) in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; and
- (3) The waiting of Disabled Persons' vehicles in accordance with the "Orange Badge" Scheme.
