##### *The West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council (Bradford) (Traffic Regulation) (No. 29) Order 1980*

##### *The West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council (Calderdale) (Traffic Regulation) (No. 10) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that the West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. ##### *The West Yorkshire Metropolitan County Council (Kirklees) (Traffic Regulation) (No. 12) Order 1980*
