The District of Rother (Battle 34) Public Path Diversion Order 1980

EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of East Sussex (Bexhill No. 26a) Public Path Diversion Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") made on 13th November 1980 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for confirmation or to be confirmed without modification by East Sussex County Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the public footpath known as Bexhill No. 26a which runs from Peartree Lane to Broadoak Lane from a point at the south-eastern corner of Parcel No. 852 as shown on the 1930 edition of the Ordnance Survey eastwards to a point near Oldebarne Farm. The new path will run from the same point north-eastwards and eastwards for a distance of 109 metres and then proceed south-eastwards for a distance of 17 metres to a point in Broadoak Lane near Oldebarne Farm.

Existing and proposed routes are described in Parts 1 and 2 of the Schedule to the above Order and shown on the map attached to the Order.

Copies of the Order and map have been deposited at the Offices of the Rother District Council, Town Hall, Bexhill-on-Sea, and at the offices of the County Records Officer, Pelham House, St. Andrews Lane, Lewes, and may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours.
