NEW TOWNS ACT 1965

Extinguishment of Public Rights of Way, Central Lancashire New Town, Parts of Back Lane, Clayton Le Woods, Chorley.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1965, proposes to make an Order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following routes shown hatched black on the map hereinafter referred to:

That part of Back Lane starting from a point marked A on the map approximately 20 metres to the north-west of Back Lane Reservoir and running in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 50 metres to a point marked B on the map;

That part of Back Lane starting from a point marked C on the map approximately 25 metres south of the roundabout for the new local distributor road and running in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 63 metres to a point marked D on the map.

A map showing the rights of way proposed to be extinguished may be inspected at the offices of the Central Lancashire Development Corporation, Cuerden Hall, Bamber Bridge, Preston, during normal office hours. Any objection to the proposal must be made in writing, clearly stating all the grounds of the objection, and addressed to the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB, not later than 1st January 1981.
