Roads forming the Boundary but not included in the Zone
Lindridge Lane, between its junction with the B3195 Exeter Road and the easterly fenceline of the A380 Kingsteignton By-pass.

A380 Kingsteignton By-pass
between Lindridge Lane overbridge and Humber Lane overbridge;
between Humber Lane overbridge and Hackney Lane underbridge;
between Hackney Lane underbridge and the River Teign.

B3195 Newton Road, between its crossing of the River Teign and its junction with Oakford.

B3195 Oakford, between its junction with Newton Road and its junction with Gestridge Road.

B3195 Gestridge Road, between its junction with Oakford and its junction with Exeter Road.

B3195 Exeter Road, between its junction with Gestridge Road and its junction with Lindridge Lane.

Humber Lane, between a point adjacent to the easterly fenceline of the A380 Kingsteignton By-pass and its junction with Three Trees Lane.

ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

A. *The Essex County Council (Chelmsford Road and A130, Rawreth) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1980*

B. *The Essex County Council (Chelmsford Road and A130, Rawreth) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 30th December 1980, the Essex County Council made the above-named Orders under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.

The Orders will come into operation on 5th January 1981 and will:

A. Prohibit all vehicles from entering or leaving Chelmsford Road, Rawreth at the junction with the A130.

B. (i) Prohibit all vehicles from entering, from the Chelmsford Road, Rawreth, the newly-constructed link road between the A130 and Chelmsford Road; and (ii) prohibit all vehicles, except buses, from entering, from the A130, Rawreth, the newly constructed link road.

Copies of the Orders and maps showing the roads in question are available at County Hall, Chelmsford where they may be examined during normal office hours from Mondays to Fridays.

If you wish to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, you may, within 6 weeks from 30th December 1980, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

GRAVESHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

Gravesham Borough Council (Whitepost Lane, Culverstone) (One-way Traffic) Order 1981

HAVANT BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Havant (Prohibition of Driving—Bus Lane, Crookhorn Lane, Purbrook) Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd December 1980, the Council of the Borough of Havant acting on behalf of the Hampshire County Council, pursuant to an arrangement entered into under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit the use by vehicles, save for the undermentioned exceptions, of the "bus only" lane extending for a length of approximately 90 metres situated on the east side of Crookhorn Lane opposite the Purbrook Chase Precinct.

The Order does not apply to the following classes of vehicles when used as such:

(a) stage carriages as defined in section 117 of the Road Traffic Act 1960;

(b) scheduled express carriages;

(c) school buses being vehicles adapted to carry eight or more passengers and used for providing transport in pursuance of arrangements made under subsection (1) of section 55 of the Education Act 1944;

(d) works buses; and

(e) fire appliances, police vehicles and ambulances.

The alternative route available for traffic is via Crookhorn Lane, Purbrook.

The Order will come into operation on 5th January 1981, and a copy of it as made together with a copy of the relevant map may be inspected at the Civic Offices, Civic Centre Road, Havant, on any weekday (excluding Saturdays) between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B and 84C of the Act or any regulation made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
