### CERTIFICATES OF TAX DEPOSIT (SERIES 5)

On and after Monday 9th February 1981, the rates of interest applicable to deposits accepted under the Prospectus (series 5) dated 31st July 1980 and applied in payment of a scheduled liability will be 12½ per cent. The rate of interest on deposits withdrawn for cash will be 10 per cent. An interest supplement, which is only payable in respect of a deposit applied in payment of a scheduled liability, of ½ per cent. Will be paid in respect of the first 2 months of a deposit. #### TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS

1. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Registrar's Office (Bank Buildings) at the Bank of England on Friday 13th February 1981 at 1 p.m., for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act 1877, and the National Loans Act 1968, to the amount of £100,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £5,000, £10,000, £25,000, £50,000, £100,000, £250,000 or £1,000,000. They will be dated at the option of the tenderer on any
