

SCHEDULE

The Smoke Control area is enclosed by a boundary from the junction of Burnley Road East and Turnpike, proceeding up Turnpike towards Newchurch until the junction with Naze Road; proceed north along Naze Road, and where this becomes a track 65 metres north of Greendale Avenue, follow the bifurcation leading to the ruined buildings west of the disused quarry at Scout and further to the junction with Scout Road at No. 6, Rosehill; the boundary then follows the retaining wall enclosing the gardens on the south-east side of Rosehill and north of No. 2, Scout Houses, following the plot boundary east to Whitewell Brook on the north side of the former site of No. 11, Southolme Terrace. At Hollin Bridge proceed north-east along Burnley Road East and then south-east along Shawclough Road, south along Edgeside Lane, turning east to include Acre Hill and then turning south along the foot-path marked on the west side of plot No. 1000 leading to (and including) Meadow Top Farm; skirting on east side of the farm around plot No. 0081, proceed south along boundary between plots Nod. 0081 and 1780, 0966 and 2269, 2055 and 3163, skirting east of (and including) Farm Hill Farm to Ward boundary; follow cart track leading due south to Piper Bank at the junction of Edgeside Lane and Fearn Moss; proceed south-south-east along Fearn Moss to the junction with Booth Road; proceed west along Booth Road to the junction with Burnley Road East and Turnpike.
