## THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The County Council of Dyfed (Llanelli to Pontardulais (Halfway, Llanelli to Talyclun, Hendy) Classified Road (Side Roads) Order 1980.*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has confirmed with modifications the above Order which was made by the County Council of Dyfed under sections 1, 3 and 62 of the Highways Act 1971 and which as confirmed, provides for authorising the Council.

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (b) to stop up highways,
- (c) to construct new highways,
- (d) to stop up private means of access to premises,
- (e) to provide new means of access to premises,

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road which the Council are proposing to construct from Halfway, Llanelli to Talyclun, Hendy.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1971 or on the ground that any requirement of the Highways Act 1959 or the Highways Act 1971 or the Highways Act 1980 or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of 1st May 1981, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.
