DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Derbyshire County Council (Park Estate, Ashbourne) (Weight Restriction) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Derbyshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2), and (3) of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of this Order will be to prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle the gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order for:

- (a) The purpose of loading/unloading to premises on or adjacent to the lengths of road;
- (b) The purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the lengths of road;
- (c) In connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or re-construction, the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of a telegraphic line, as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878 in or adjacent to the lengths of road;
- (d) Stage carriage, works or school bus and emergency services;
- (e) In the course of military training operations.

Full details of the proposal are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the restricted length of road and a statement of the council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at Room 109, County Offices, Matlock (Mr. B. Wood) between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday and at the West Derbyshire District Council, Compton Offices, Ashbourne during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 25th May 1981.

The County of Devon (Abingdon Road, Plymouth) (Disabled Person's Parking Place) Amendment Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 29th April 1981, the Devon County Council made the above Orders under sections 28 (1), 31 (1) and 84 (D) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to remove the disabled person's parking places by rescinding the following Orders:

- (i) The County of Devon (Beaumont Avenue, Plymouth) (Disabled Person's Parking Place) Order 1980.
- (ii) The County of Devon (Abingdon Road, Plymouth) (Disabled Person's Parking Place) Order 1980.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Mill Road, Okehampton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 1980

Notice is hereby given that on the 30th April 1981 the Devon County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is:

- (a) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Saturday, on part of the west side of Mill Road.
- (b) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on any day on parts of the west and east sides of Mill Road.
- (c) To revoke The County of Devon (Mill Road, Okehampton) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1976.

Exceptions are provided in the Order permitting waiting for the purpose of boarding and alighting, loading and unloading, building and demolition, roadworks and the maintenance of essential services. Exceptions are also provided for disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the orange badge scheme.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 30th April 1981 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Order will come into force on 1st May 1981.
