(iii), (iv) and (v) above may be by coins of the denomination of 10 new pence.

- (b) the excess charge payable to the City Council in respect of those metered parking places in the streets listed in Schedules 1 and 2 to this notice would be £8; in respect of those streets listed in Schedules 3 and 4 the charge would be £4; in respect of those streets listed in Schedule 5 the charge would be £2; and the excess charge period in all cases would be one hour.
