Brazil: Official Certificate

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly give notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97), as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and 1979 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351 and S.I. 1979 No. 1426), and the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978 (S.I. 1978 No. 272) they hereby restrict recognition of the Official Certificates reproduced in the First Schedule to the notice published in the *London Gazette* dated 3rd December 1968 for the importation of meat and meat products from Brazil, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

PETROLEUM AND SUBMARINE PIPE-LINES ACT 1975

Notice of the Issue of Submarine Pipeline Works Authorisations

The Secretary of State for Energy hereby gives notice that submarine pipeline works authorisations have been issued to Occidental Petroleum (Caledonia) Limited, whose registered office is at 16 Palace Street, London SW1E 5BQ, for construction and use of two pipeline systems within the Claymore Field. One pipeline system will comprise of one pipe of 10½ inches external diameter and two pipes of 8½ inches external diameter inside an outer casing of 26½ inches external diameter. The other pipeline system will comprise of a pipe of 6½ inches external diameter inside an outer casing of 14 inches external diameter.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the pipelines may only be used to convey well injection water. The pipelines may be used by the holder and certain other bodies specified in the authorisations and, with the holder's agreement, and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons. Occidental Petroleum (Caledonia) Limited has been appointed operator of the pipelines.
