

Sheen Road and Paradise Road on the south side of Sheen Road and re-defining them as one parking place.

3. The proposed Order would:

- (a) revoke the designation by the Richmond-upon-Thames (Parking Places) Order 1973, of the three 2-hour metered parking places on the south side of Sheen Road, fronting the Christian Science Church, Wilton Court, Carrington Lodge, and the old Ritz Cinema site;
- (b) designate a 2-hour metered parking place on the south side of Sheen Road, from a point fronting the Christian Science Church, westward to a point fronting the old Ritz Cinema site;
- (c) provide that the parking place would operate between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m., Monday to Saturday inclusive (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted);
- (d) specify that:
 - (i) in respect of the parking place the initial charge would be at the rate of ten new pence for a period of forty minutes plus any unexpired time shown on the parking meter provided that the maximum initial period does not exceed 2 hours;
 - (ii) in respect of the metered parking places, the excess charge—payable to the Borough—would be £3; the excess charge period would be 2 hours; the unexpired time shown on the parking meter may be used free of charge; and the period during which vehicles may not return to a parking place would be 1 hour;

(e) specify that certain vehicles may wait free of charge in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), or vehicles left by specified disabled persons (no time limit).

4. A copy of the proposed Order, of the Richmond-upon-Thames (Parking Places) Order 1973 (and of the Orders which have amended or applied that Order), of a map showing the length of road to which the Order relates and of the statement setting out the Council's reasons for applying for the Order can be inspected at the under-mentioned premises until 2nd June 1981:

- (a) between 9.15 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive at the Director of Technical Services Department (2nd Floor), Regal House, London Road, Twickenham; the Municipal Offices, Twickenham; and the Richmond Town Hall, Hill Street, Richmond; and
- (b) between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, and 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Saturdays at the Richmond Central Library, Little Green, Richmond.

5. Any persons wishing to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of his/her objections and the grounds thereof to the Director of Planning and Transportation, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB, quoting Ref. PT/TD/O/PK not later than the date specified in paragraph 4 above.

St. Helens Borough Council (West End Road and Clipsley Lane) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1981

No Waiting at Any Time

West End Road

On its northerly side from opposite a point 15 yards (13.7 metres) east of its junction with Worsley Street to opposite a point 21 yards (19.2 metres) west of its junction with School Street.

On its northerly side, from a point 15 yards (13.7 metres) west of its junction with West Side Avenue to a point 15 yards (13.7 metres) east of its junction with West Side Avenue.
