

or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs, modify or suspend the Order or any provision thereof.

4. The general effect of the Restriction of Waiting on Bus Stops Order will be further to amend the Hounslow (Restriction of Waiting on Bus Stops) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1974, so that the restrictions on waiting by vehicles as imposed by that Order which apply on the bus stops which lie within the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this notice would cease to apply thereto and instead, that such restrictions as imposed by the Hounslow (Restriction of Waiting on Bus Stops) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1978 will apply to the relocated bus stops sited within the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

5. A copy of the Prescribed Route Order, which will come into operation on 18th May 1981, and of the Council's statement of reasons for making the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 6 months from that date in Room B.21, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

6. A copy of the Restriction of Waiting on Bus Stops Order, which will come into operation on 18th May 1981, of the Hounslow (Restriction of Waiting on Bus Stops) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1974 and of the Hounslow (Restriction of Waiting on Bus Stops) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1978 (and of the Orders which have previously amended those Orders) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made in Room B.21, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

7. Copies of the Orders may be obtained from the Transportation and Development Department, Room 578, Main Building, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

8. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or on the ground that any requirement of those sections of the Act or of sections 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to either of the Orders may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

9. If the provisions of the Prescribed Route Order continue in operation for a period of not less than 6 months, the Council will consider in due course whether

the provisions of the Order should be reproduced and continued in force indefinitely by means of an Order under section 6 of the said Act of 1967. Any person desiring to object to the making of the Order under section 6 of the said Act of 1967 for the purpose of such reproduction and continuation in force may, within the afore-mentioned period of 6 months, send a statement in writing of his objection and the grounds thereof to the Controller of Transportation and Development, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB, quoting the Ref. TD/HT/O/A.
