

Moorland Avenue

West side, from a point 35 metres south-west of the north side of Skellingthorpe Road northwards to its junction with Skellingthorpe Road.

West side, from a point 57 metres south-west of the north side of Skellingthorpe Road south-westwards for a distance of 25 metres.

East side, opposite a point situate on the west side of Moorland Avenue 82 metres south-west of the north side of Skellingthorpe Road north-eastwards to its junction with Rookery Lane.

MIDDLESBROUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL**Middlesbrough Borough Council (Roman Road/Rockcliffe Road) Restriction of Waiting Order 1981**

Notice is hereby given that on 27th April 1981, the Middlesbrough Borough Council made the above-named Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

This Order will come into operation on 17th May 1981 and from that date it will be unlawful to leave a vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive on those lengths of road described in the Schedule to this notice.

There are certain exemptions from the effect of this Order for example in favour of disabled persons' vehicles which are displaying a disabled person's badge.
