#### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The County Council of Dorset (the A354 Weymouth to Portland Road) (Diversion of East Fleet) Order 1981*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Dorset hereby give notice that they have made, and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation, an Order under section 108 of the Highways Act 1980 for authorising the Council in connection with the improvement of the A354 Weymouth to Portland Road to divert a length of the navigable watercourse known as the East Fleet where it enters Portland Harbour at Ferry Bridge through a new length of watercourse to be provided approximately 139 metres south of the southern end of Ferry Bridge.

##### NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

#### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

#### COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1968

*The County Council of Isle of Wight, Public Footpath SW9 Limerstone, Public Path Diversion Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 6th May 1981 the County Council of Isle of Wight confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order, as confirmed without modifications, is to divert:

(i) that part of Public Footpath SW9 commencing on the north side of the Limerstone/Brightstone Road and running along the eastern boundary of the property known as "Foredown" then in a northerly direction through a field gate, and

(ii) that part of Public Footpath SW9 commencing 380 metres north of the main entrance of "Foredown" proceeding from the north-eastern corner of OS 5200 westwards for 115 metres then northwards through a field gate to run northerly over the westward part of OS 5116 then leaving by a field gate 45 metres from the north-west corner of that parcel to proceed in a northerly direction to join Public Bridleway SW6,

to a line:

(i) to commence from OS 4572 40 metres west of the entrance to "Foredown" then northerly parallel to the western boundary of "Foredown" then easterly along the northern boundary of "Foredown" to meet the present route at the field gate, and

(ii) to commence 380 metres north of the main entrance of "Foredown" then northwards to the south-eastern corner of OS 5116 then northwards along its eastern boundary through a gateway to continue on the inside of the western boundary of OS 8614 in a northerly direction to join with Public Bridleway SW6.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the Reception Desk County Hall, Newport, Isle of Wight between 9.30 a.m. and 4 p.m. on weekdays.

The Order becomes operative as from 3rd June 1981 but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the
