##### *Designation of Conservation Area*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth in pursuance of their powers under section 277 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, as amended by section 1 of the Town and Country Amenities Act 1974, have designated certain land situate in the Streatham area of Lambeth including the land described in the Schedule hereto as the Leigham Court Road (South) Conservation Area No. 28.

The object of such designation is to preserve or enhance the character or appearance of an area of special architectural or historic interest as distinct from individual buildings, to control development in the areas and to stimulate and encourage measures to improve the environment.

*The North Yorkshire County Council, Footpath No. 1, West Ayton, Public Path Diversion Order 1980*

Notice is hereby given that on 13th April 1981 the Secretary of State for the Environment confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public right of way known as Footpath No. 1 in the Parish of West Ayton, which runs from a point S.E. 98 987858 proceeding in a south-easterly direction across O.S. Field No. 7000 running approximately parallel to the River Derwent which is east of the path, it then bends in a southerly direction alongside a meander in the river and continues south running parallel approximately 9 metres from the boundary of Stonyflat Wood, the path then curves south-westerly tapering towards the southern boundary of Stonyflat Wood and ends at Grid Reference SE 98 989854. The new route commences at point SE 98 987858 and runs along the eastern boundary of Stonyflat Wood through O.S. Field No. 7000 in a southerly direction and passes the crags on the eastern side of Stonyflat Wood ending at Grid Reference SE 98 989854.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited and may be inspected free of charge at the North York Moors National Park Office, The Old Vicarage, Bondgate, Helmsley, North Yorkshire, during office hours.

The Order becomes operative as from 12th May 1981 but if a person aggrieved by the Order decides to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1959, as amended, or any regulation made thereunder, if it has not been complied with in relation to the Order he may within 6 weeks from 12th May 1981 make an application for that purpose to the High Court.
