ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

AVON COUNTY COUNCIL

County of Avon (Doctor Parking Places) (District of Kingswood) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Avon propose to make an Order under sections 35, 36 and 37 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be:

- (1) to prohibit any person, other than the medical practitioner who holds the permit issued by the County Council, from parking any vehicle between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a bank holiday on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice;
- (2) to charge £40 per annum in connection with the issue of each permit in respect of the parking space.

GREATER MANCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

The Greater Manchester County (Various Roads, Rochdale) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (County) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Greater Manchester County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to:

- (a) *Prohibit Waiting at any time*
King Street, easterly side, from its junction with Nelson Street to a point 10 metres north of its junction with Nelson Street.
Nelson Street
Northerly side, from a point 38 metres west of Drake Street to a point 56 metres west of Drake Street.
Southerly side, from its junction with Packer Street to a point 10 metres east of its junction with Packer Street.
Southerly side, from its junction with Church Lane to a point 10 metres west of its junction with Church Lane.
Church Lane
Westerly side, from its junction with Nelson Street to a point 15 metres south of its junction with Nelson Street.
Easterly side, from a point 10 metres north of its junction with Nelson Street to its junction with School Lane.
Water Street, southerly side, from its junction with Robinson Street to a point 50 metres east of its junction with Robinson Street.
The Esplanade
Southerly side, along that length of the island gardens situated at the front of the Town Hall.
Northerly side, from a point 95 metres east of Town Meadows for a distance of 30 metres in an easterly direction.

- (b) *Prohibit Waiting from Monday to Saturday between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.*
Baillie Street, southerly side, from a point 30 metres east of Lyceum Passage to its junction with Constantine Road.

- (c) *Limit Waiting from Monday to Saturday between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. to 1 hour return prohibited within 1 hour on the following length of road*
The Esplanade, northerly side of the northerly carriageway, from its junction with Town Meadows to a point 95 metres east of its junction with Town Meadows.

- (d) *Prohibit Loading or Unloading at any time*
The Butts, northerly side, from its junction with Constantine Road to a point 25 metres west of Constantine Road.

- (e) *Prohibit Loading or Unloading from Monday to Saturday between 7.30 and 9.30 a.m. and 4 and 6 p.m.*
Smith Street, southerly side, from its junction with Drake Street to a point 18 metres east of Faulkner Street.

The proposed Order contains exemptions to permit waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, loading or unloading, funerals, building operations or work on or under the lengths of road. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled persons' badge will be allowed to wait for up to two hours, return prohibited within one hour.
