Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Service Road, Stratford Road) (One Way Traffic) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council as agent of the West Midlands County Council on 15th May 1981 made the above-mentioned Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

The effect of the Order will be that no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the under-mentioned roads, in a direction other than that specified:

The length of the service road fronting Shirley Clinic, opposite numbers 275 to 293 Stratford Road, which extends from a point approximately 25 metres south-east of the Stratford Road/Longmore Road Junction to a point approximately 66 metres south-east of the Stratford Road/Solihull Road Junction.	From south-east to north-west.
The length of the service road described above from a point approximately 57 metres south-east of the Stratford Road/Solihull Road Junction to a point approximately 38 metres south-east of that Junction.	From south-east to north-west.

Notice is hereby given that the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council as agent of the West Midlands County Council on 15th May 1981 made the above-mentioned Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting on the following lengths of road:

- Both sides of Alder Lane, from its junction with Gipsy Lane for a distance of approximately 37 metres in an easterly direction from that junction.

- Both sides of Holly Lane, from its junction with Alder Lane and Balsall Street East for a distance of approximately 37 metres in a south-westerly direction from that junction.

The Spelthorne Borough Council (Various Roads, Staines) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment No. 9) Order 1981.

Notice is hereby given that Spelthorne Borough Council as agent of Surrey County Council, has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended, and all other enabling powers, the effect of which is as follows:

WEST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

The County Council of West Sussex (Chichester: Northgate Circulatory) (Cycle Lane) Order 1981

The cycle will be 2 metres in width and will extend around the whole of the Northgate Circulatory along the nearside kerb-line and also for short distances along the following approach roads to the system along their nearside kerb-lines:

Broyle Road, Oaklands Way, North Street, Orchard Street and St. Paul's Road.

The Order will prohibit any vehicle driving or waiting in the cycle lane subject to certain limited exceptions.
