- (1) *West Sussex County Council (Lindfield Rural) Public Path (No. 24B) Diversion Order 1981*

- (1) Divert part of footpath No. 24B in the Parish of Lindfield Rural, by stopping up the path commencing at its junctions with footpaths Nos. 24A and 25, extending south-south-westwards for approximately 1,720 feet and substituting for that path a new length

of public footpath, a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing at a point on footpath No. 24A approximately 110 feet north-west of its original junction, extending generally south-westwards following the new western boundary of the golf course for approximately 1,900 feet, thence generally eastwards for approximately 500 feet on a southern headland to join the southern end of the length of path to be stopped up.

- (2) Divert part of footpath No. 2 in the Parish of Bolney by stopping up the path commencing at its junction with the maintainable highway (Jeremy's Lane) extending northwards for approximately 120 feet, thence westwards for approximately 190 feet, passing through the garden of Bramble Cottage, and substituting for that path a new length of public footpath a minimum width of 6 feet, commencing at a point on Jeremy's Lane, approximately 230 feet west of its original junction, extending northwards for approximately 210 feet at the side of an old quarry to join the western end of the length of path to be stopped up.
