TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of Mary

Street at Portsmouth in the County of Hampshire to enable development consisting of the extension to a school playground to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted by Hampshire County Council under Part III of the said Act.
