THE IMPORTATION OF ANIMALS ORDER 1977
(ARTICLE 3 (2))

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, by this licence issued under Article 3 (2) of the Importation of Animals Order 1977, hereby authorises the landing in Great Britain, in accordance with the conditions set out below, of:

England General Import Licence No. 16 dated 17 May 1978 is hereby revoked.

This licence is valid until varied or revoked by the Minister.

Conditions

1. All landings of goats shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Importation of Animals Order 1977 and with the following provisions of this licence.
2. Shipment must be direct from Jersey to Great Britain.

3. The goats, having landed at the airport specified above, shall immediately be taken under the terms of the Importation Order, to an approved Reception Centre linked with that airport, as specified below:

<i>Airport of Landing</i>	<i>Linked Reception Centre</i>
Hurn Airport	Hurn Airport Lairage

4. Each consignment of goats shall be accompanied by the following document:

A certificate of a veterinary officer appointed by the Government of Jersey stating that:

the goats were inspected by him immediately before they were consigned to Great Britain and found to be healthy and fit to travel; they have been kept separate from animals not so certified.

Notes

1. Any person wishing to land animals in Great Britain under the terms of this licence must make arrangements in advance, with the occupier of the reception centre to which the animals are intended to be taken after landing, for accommodation of the animals. The address of the occupier may be obtained from the local Divisional Veterinary Officer of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food.

2. The carrier of imported animals must, in accordance with Article 4 (7) of the Importation of Animals Order 1977, notify the person in charge of the approved reception centre to which those animals are licensed to be moved of the proposed time of landing of those animals, and of their number and description.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A COMBINED LICENCE TO OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AN INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IM- POUNDING WORKS AND TO ABSTRACT WATER.

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Anglian Water Authority, Essex River Division by Hon. P. A. Strutt, Stutton Hall, Stutton, Ipswich, Suffolk IP9 2TQ, for a combined licence to obstruct or impede the flow of Stutton Brook by means of dam or sill at TM 1330 3494 and to abstract 12,000,000 gallons of water per year from the said inland water at or near that point.

BEDFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Bedfordshire (Restricted Roads) (No. 1)
Order 1981*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Bedfordshire propose to apply to the Minister of Transport under section 84B of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, for consent to make an Order under section 72 (3), 73 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, prohibiting

the driving of any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following length of road in Westoning:

That length of Route A5120 which extends from a point 306 metres south of Church Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 880 metres.

*The County of Bedfordshire (Hitchin Street, Biggleswade)
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Bedfordshire propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle at all times on the following length of road in Biggleswade:

The east side of Hitchin Street from a point 30 yards south of the junction between Saffron Road and Hitchin Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 69 yards,
and between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday along the following length of road in Biggleswade:

The west side of Hitchin Street from a point 30 yards south of the junction between Saffron Road and Hitchin Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 69 yards.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to permit waiting where necessary, for the purposes of picking up
