

TYNE AND WEAR COUNTY COUNCIL

Tyne and Wear County Council (Riverside Park Access Road, Isabella Colliery) Prohibition of Entry Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Tyne and Wear County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

The effect of the proposed Order will prohibit all vehicles, proceeding on Blaney Row Access Road, from entering into the proposed Riverside Park Access Road, Isabella Colliery, at the junction west of the waterworks.

WOKING BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Woking Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Pay and Display) Amendment Order No. 4 1981

Notice is hereby given that, on the 1st May 1981, the Woking Borough Council, with the consent of the County Council of Surrey, made an Order under sections 28(1), 31(1), (2) and (4) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Local Government Act 1974.

The effect of the Order is to amend the Woking Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Pay and Display) Order 1978 by:

- (i) Controlling the use of the parking place at The Pool Multi-Storey Car Park;
- (ii) Introducing the pay and display system for the collection of charges at The Pool Multi-Storey Car Park and Victoria Way Multi-Storey Car Park and the imposition of an excess charge of £5 either when a vehicle is left after the expiration of the period for which a charge has been paid or for not displaying a ticket;
- (iii) The application of the charges in the undermentioned Schedule.

A copy of the proposed Order, which will come into operation on 26th May, 1981, may be examined during normal office hours in the Chief Executive's Office, Mount Hermon Road, Woking, Surrey.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 94C of the Act or any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order made, from 15th May, 1981, the date of making the Order, make application for this purpose to the High Court.
