THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1968  
(AS AMENDED)

*Botswana : Official Certificate*

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly give notice that in the exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1968 (S.I. 1968 No. 97) as amended by the Imported Food (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and 1979 (S.I. 1973 No. 1351 and S.I. 1979 No. 1426) and the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978 (S.I. 1978 No. 272) they hereby recognise, subject to the conditions hereinafter set out, the Official Certificate of which particulars are given in the Schedule hereto as showing:

- (a) that the meat from which the meat product to which they relate was prepared, was derived from mammals inspected before and after death in the country of origin of the meat and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Minister and
- (b) that the dressing, packing and other preparation of the meat and the meat product was carried out with all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to health.

The said certificate is recognised subject to the following conditions:

- (b) The recognition will apply only if the stamps are meat products from Botswana.
- (b) The recognition will apply only if the stamps are clearly impressed or otherwise marked on the can or on the label surrounding the can.
- (c) Recognition of the Official Certificate is restricted to those Certificates completed by the insertion of the establishment number shown in the schedule hereto.

NOTE. Imports of meat and meat products from certain countries are restricted and in some cases prohibited on animal health grounds by the Importation of Animal Products and Poultry Products Order 1980, as amended. The recognition of an Official Certificate for public health purposes does not give exemption from such restrictions or prohibitions. (4 SI)
