NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY LICENCE  
TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Yorkshire Water Authority by Tootal Limited to vary the Licence, serial number 2/27/15/20 (to abstract water from Eller Beck, Skipton, North Yorkshire, at SD 95/992526, SD 95/989518, SD 95/985515).

The variation applied for is:

- (i) To cancel SD 95/992526 and SD 95/989518 which are no longer in use and to amend the position of the remaining abstraction point to SD 95/9865 5158.
- (ii) To change the purpose for which the water is authorised to be used to the following:
  - (a) Dyehouse Process Water—non-returned supply;
  - (b) Dyehouse Cooling Water—uncontaminated return to stream supply for use as cooling water.
- (iii) To amend the quantities of water authorised to be abstracted as follows:

(a) Dyehouse Process Water:

Amend from 30,000 gallons per hour to 9,900 gallons per hour, 500,000 gallons per day 9900 gallons per hour, 500,000 gallons per day to 198,000 gallons per day, 115.5 million gallons per annum (returned supply), to 45.54 million gallons per annum (non-returned supply).

(b) Dyehouse Cooling Water:

Amend from 2,100 gallons per hour to 3,300 gallons per hour, 50,000 gallons per day to 49,500 gallons per day, 9.6 million gallons per annum (non-returned supply), to 11.44 million gallons per annum (returned uncontaminated to stream).
