## MID GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

Mid Glamorgan County Council (Van Terrace and Unnamed Road Leading from Van Road to Van Terrace, Caerphilly) (Prohibition and Limitation of Waiting) Order 1981.

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effects of which will be:

- (i) to prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the sides of lengths of roads described in the Schedule to this notice;
- (ii) to limit the waiting of vehicles to 30 minutes with return prohibited within 1 hour in the lay-by situated on the eastern side of the un-named road leading from Van Road to Van Terrace, Caerphilly, from a point 10 metres (11 yards) south of the southern side of Van Terrace southwards to a point 50 metres (55 yards) north of its junction with Van Road, a distance of approximately 23 metres (25 yards).

Exemptions will be provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and roadworks, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and the delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour where waiting is prohibited at any time and will be exempted where limited waiting applies.

A copy of the proposed Order, a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, and a map showing the sides of lengths of roads to which the proposed Order relates, may be inspected at the offices of the Rhymney Valley District Council, Council Offices, Park Road, Hengoed, and at the Mid Glamorgan County Hall, Cathays Park, Cardiff, during normal office hours.

Sides of Lengths of Roads in the District of Rhymney Valley

- (i) The western side of the unnamed road leading from Van Road to Van Terrace, Caerphilly, from its junction with Van Road to its junction with Van Terrace, a distance of approximately 80 metres (88 yards).
- (ii) The eastern side of the unnamed road leading from Van Road to Van Terrace, Caerphilly, from its junction with Van Road northwards for a distance of 50 metres (55 yards).
- (iii) The eastern side of the unnamed road leading from Van Road to Van Terrace, Caerphilly, from its junction with Van Terrace, southwards for a distance of 10 metres 11 yards).
- (iv) The southern side of Van Terrace, Caerphilly, from the eastern side of its junction with the unnamed road leading from Van Road to Van Terrace, eastwards for a distance of 10 metres (11 yards).

Mid Glamorgan County Council (Route B4255 Adjacent to Taff Merthyr Colliery, Trelewis) (Revocation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1981.

Notice is hereby given that the Mid Glamorgan County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effects of which will be:

(i) to revoke the "Mid Glamorgan County Council (Taff Merthyr Colliery (Route B4255), Trelewis) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978," which prohibits the waiting of vehicles at any time on both sides of Route B4255 adjacent to the Taff Merthyr Colliery, Trelewis, from a point 50 metres (55 yards) north of the northern side of the main entrance to the Colliery southwards for a distance of 100 metres (110 yards);

(ii) to prohibit the waiting of cehicles at any time on both sides of Route B4255 adjacent to the main entrance to the Taff Merthyr Colliery, Trelewis, from a point 475 metres (519 yards) north of the northern side of the main entrance to the Colliery, southwards for a distance of 750 metres (820 yards).

Exemptions will be provided in the Order for the purposes of boarding, alighting, loading and unloading, building and roadworks, the maintenance of essential services, weddings, funerals and delivery or collection of postal packets by vehicles in the service of the Post Office. Disabled persons' vehicles displaying the relevant disabled person's badge will be allowed to wait for up to 2 hours with return prohibited within 1 hour.

#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The Hampshire (Various Roads, Alton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) and (Consolidation) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 14th May 1981 the Hampshire County Council have made an Order in exercise of their powers under section 1(1), (2), (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for Hampshire the effect of which is:

- (a) to revoke the Orders set out in the First Schedule to this notice;
- (b) to prohibit vehicles from waiting at any time in any of the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this notice;
- (c) to prohibit vehicles from waiting between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. in any of the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this notice;
- (d) to prohibit vehicles from waiting for longer than 1 hour in any of the lengths of road specified in the Fourth Schedule to this notice; and
- (e) to consolidate in this Order the existing restrictions contained in the Orders referred to at (a) above except in relation to the lengths or roads referred to in those Orders which are also listed in the Second Schedule of this Notice, which will be subject to the new restrictions referred to at (b) above.

The Order contains the usual exemptions to allow for the picking up and setting down of passengers and for the loading and unloading of goods and also for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge.

A copy of the Order and a copy of the plan showing the lengths of road in question may be inspected at the offices of the Secretary and Solicitor, East Hampshire District Council, Penn's Place, Durford Road, Petersfield; the Local Presence Officer, 7 Cross and Pillory Lane, Alton, and at the offices of the undersigned during normal office hours.
