ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Sansome Walk, Worcester) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1981.

Notice is hereby given that on 13th May 1981 the County Council of Hereford and Worcester made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be:

- (1) to prohibit waiting at any time on the side of length of Sansome Walk in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester as described in the First Schedule to this notice;
- (2) to maintain the existing restriction which prohibits waiting between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturday inclusive on the side of length of road in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester specified in the Second Schedule to this notice:
 - (i) for a period exceeding 45 minutes; or
 - (ii) if a period of less than 1½ hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours or the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on that side of length of road.

The Order will come into operation on Wednesday, 27th May 1981.

A copy of the Order as made and a copy of the relevant map can be inspected at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in the Order on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of that section or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act of 1967 or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made (such date stated in this notice) make application for the purpose to the High Court.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Side of length of road in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester

Sansome Walk, western side, from a point 14 metres (45 feet) south of its junction with St. Mary's Street for a distance of 18 metres (58 feet) in a southerly direction.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Side of length of road in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester

Sansome Walk, western side, from a point 32 metres (103 feet) south of its junction with St. Mary's Street in a southerly direction to a point 5 metres (16 feet) south of its junction with Taylors Lane.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

The County of Hereford and Worcester (Church Bank and Wolverley Village) (One-way) Traffic Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Hereford and Worcester propose to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be to prevent any vehicle from proceeding in the following lengths of roads in a direction other than south to north:

The lengths of roads known as Church Bank and Wolverley Village which extends from its western

junction with B4189 Wolverley Road to a point 21 metres (69 feet) north of the centre of the bridge, a distance of approximately 260 metres (853 feet).

Full details of this proposal are contained in the draft Order which together with a map showing the lengths of roads affected and statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined from Monday to Friday during normal office hours at:

EAST HERTFORDSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL

East Hertfordshire District Council (Experimental Traffic Orders—Church Street and Crib Street, Ware) 1981

Notice is hereby given that the East Hertfordshire District Council propose to make two Orders under the provisions of section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which will be:

- (a) to impose one-way traffic flow from south to north in Church Street, Ware from its most eastern junction with High Street to its most western junction with High Street, Ware;
- (b) to prohibit all persons from causing or permitting any heavy commercial vehicle having a weight of 3 tons or over from proceeding along Crib Street, Ware, except for access, for the following specified purposes:
 - (i) For or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated in Crib Street, Princes Street, Francis Road, The Maltings, Coronation Road and Century Road;
 - (ii) In connection with the carrying out on, or any premises situated in Crib Street, Princes Street, Francis Road, The Maltings, Coronation Road and Century Road, any of the following:
 - (A) Building, industrial or demolition operations,
 - (B) the removal of obstructions to traffic,
 - (C) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road,
 - (D) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or on land adjacent to the road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.
 - (iii) For Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes.
 - (iv) To proceed to or from any premises which are situated in Crib Street, Princes Street, Francis Road, The Maltings, Coronation Road and Century Road, which the vehicle is to be or has been garaged, serviced or repaired.
 - (v) In the service of a Local Authority or Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
 - (vi) On that road for or in connection with the conveyance of goods for sale from the vehicle.

A copy of the draft Orders and plan showing the proposals together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Council Offices, The Causeway, Bishops Stortford, and at The Priory, Ware, on Mondays to Fridays during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection, in writing, to the undersigned by not later than Friday, 19th June 1981.
