CUMBRIA COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cumbria (U795 Kent Place, Kendal) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 15th May 1981, the Cumbria County Council made the above-named Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (Prohibition of Driving) (Chitterleigh Farm Silverton) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd May 1981 the Devon County Council made an Order under sections 1 and 84C(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended. The Order will come into operation on 1st June 1981 and its effect will be to prohibit the driving of vehicles in that section of the link road at Chitterleigh Farm, Silverton from the A396 for a distance of approximately 25 metres.
