

Huntspill, which point is approximately 50 metres north-west of the junction of Church Road and Sunny Close, in a northerly direction for a total distance of approximately 41 metres, to run from a point on the north side of Church Road, which point is approximately 70 metres north-west of the junction of Church Road and Sunny Close, in a north-easterly direction and thence in a south-easterly direction for a total distance of approximately 53 metres to reconnect with the remainder of Footpath No. BW 35/1.
