NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

The District of Horsham (Footpath No. 1889 (Part)) Public Path Diversion Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 209 and section 216 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, proposes to make an Order if planning permission is granted for residential development on land at Rascal's Wood, off Shipley Road, Southwater, Sussex, the effect of which will be to divert that part of Footpath No. 1889 starting from a point approximately 14 metres from its junction with Shipley Road, marked A on the map hereinafter referred to, and extending in a generally north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 147 metres to a point marked G on the map, to a new line starting from the afore-mentioned point marked A and extending in a generally westerly direction for a distance of approximately 37 metres to a point marked B on the map, then in a generally westerly direction for a distance

of approximately 10.5 metres to a point marked C on the map, then in a generally north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 26 metres to a point marked D on the map, and then in a generally westerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres to a point marked E on the map, then in a generally north-westerly direction bearing south-westerly for a distance of approximately 63 metres to a point marked F on the map and then in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 17 metres to rejoin the existing path at the point marked G on the map.

The lines and situations of the existing and proposed alternate highways are shown on the map annexed to the draft Order.

A copy of the draft Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of the Horsham District Council, Park House, North Street, Horsham, and may be inspected free of charge between the hours of 8.45 a.m. and 5.20 p.m. on Mondays to Thursdays and 8.45 a.m. to 4.20 p.m. on Fridays and at the Horsham Public Library, North Street, Horsham, where they may be inspected free of charge between the hours of 9.30 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays, 9.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Thursdays and 9.30 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturdays.
