HIGHWAYS ACTS 1959 TO 1971

The Winchester-Preston (A34) Trunk Road (Botley Subway Side Roads) Order 198

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes, in relation to the above-mentioned Trunk Road at Botley in the County of Oxfordshire to make under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980 an Order which will:

- (a) authorise him:
- (i) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways;
 - (ii) to stop up a highway; and
 - (iii) to construct new highways;
- all at Botley aforesaid; and
- (b) provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Oxfordshire as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.

Any person may not later than 10th July 1981 object to the making of the Order, by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport, at his address at the office of the Regional Controller (Roads and Transportation) Eastern Region, Heron House, 49-51 Goldington Road, Bedford MK40 3LL, quoting Ref. 507109/A34/S49, and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
