The City of Durham (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 19th May 1981, the Council of the City of Durham made an Order under section 31(1) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the Highways Act 1971, and the Local Government Act 1972, which varies the City of Durham (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1980, by revising the charges in respect of the use of the car parks as shown in the Schedule to this Notice.

The £5 per day standard charge referred to in the aforementioned Order has also been revised by increasing the same to £6 per day.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 1st June 1981, may be inspected at the office of the undersigned during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks from 29th June 1981, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
