Over 4 hours, 60p. Quarterly permit charge, £24.

Charges for Motor Cycles without Sidecars Free of Charge.

Excess Charge:
£6 if paid within 14 days or £10 if paid after that time.

2. London Road:

Day of operation, all days.

Hours of operation, all hours.

Maximum period of waiting, 24 consecutive hours.

Charging hours, Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. (except Bank Holidays).

Daily Charge, 40p.

Weekly Charge, £1.70.

Excess Charge: £6 if paid within 14 days or £10 if paid after that time.

3. Denne Road:

Kingston-upon-Hull (Off Street Parking Places) (Variation of Charges) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 28th May 1981, the Kingston-upon-Hull City Council made an Order under section 31 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 amending the Schedule to the Kingston-upon-Hull (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1980 relating to the scale of charges at the Multi Storey Off Street Parking Places situate at George Street, Osborne Street and Pryme Street in the City of Kingston-upon-Hull.

The Order will come into operation on 1st June 1981 and will amend the Schedule as follows:

Within the hours of operation of the parking place:

- Vehicles (excluding motor cycles): (i) up to and including 5 hours continuous parking,
 - (ii) over 5 hours continuous parking, 60p.

Motor Cycles:

- (i) up to and including 5 hours continuous parking, 20p.
- (ii) over 5 hours continuous parking, 35p.

Parking outside the hours of operation:

- (i) Vehicles (excluding motor cycles), 60p.
- (ii) Motor cycles, 35p.

The County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, Ryde/Binstead) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1 1981

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Isle of Wight in exercise of their powers under sections 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, have made an Order the effect of which is as follows:

- (1) To revoke "The County Council of Isle of Wight (Various Streets, Ryde/Binstead) (Traffic Regulation) Order No. 1 1980".
- (2) To re-enact the provisions contained in the above Order subject to the following amendments:
 - (a) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the following lengths of road:

Ashey Road, on west side, from 45 feet south to 100 feet south of Bettesworth Road.

Barfield, on east side, from Wood Street to a point 45 feet south thereof.

Buckingham Close, on both sides, from Buckingham Road to a point 45 feet west thereof.

Buckingham Road, on both sides, from a point 70 feet east to 20 feet south-west of Buckingham Close.

Cornwall Street, on both sides, from The Esplanade to a point 25 feet south thereof.

Great Preston Road, on north side, from 45 feet west to 400 feet west of A3055 at Westridge Cross.

Melville Street, on south side, from 70 feet east to 100 feet east of George Street.

Melville Street, on south side, from 100 feet west of Monkton Street to 45 feet east of Trinity Street.

Melville Street, on south side, from 45 feet west of Trinity Street to 45 feet east of Dover Street.

Mountbatten Drive, on both sides, from 200 feet north of Pell Lane to the end of the cul-de-sac to include all sides of the turning head.

Pellhurst Road, on west side, from 45 feet south of Argyll Street to 45 feet north of Arthur Street.

Station Street, on east side, from 80 feet south to 160 feet south of Newport Street.

Swanmore Road, on both sides, from Weekes Road to 50 feet north thereof.

(b) To limit the waiting of vehicles to 30 minutes in any hour, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays in the following lengths of road:

High Street, on south-west side, from 20 feet north-east to 45 feet north-east of Well Street.
