BERKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Royal County of Berkshire (Bus Links, Bracknell) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council have made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to prohibit vehicles other than buses from proceeding in the bus links specified in Schedules 1 and 2 of this notice. Buses proceeding in the bus link specified in Schedule 2 should do so only in the direction specified in that Schedule.

It should be noted that the remaining bus links in the draft Order advertised on 29th May 1980 will be implemented at a later date.

The Order will come into operation on 15th June 1981.

Copies of the Order and relevant map can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the Bracknell District Council and at the County Secretary's Office at the address below.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended as aforesaid or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 8th June 1981, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

BERKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Royal County of Berkshire (Restricted Roads and 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (Shinfield and Swallowfield) (No.) Order 1981.

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 72 (3), 73 (1) and 74 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, the effect of which is to:

(1) Impose a speed limit of 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice.

(2) Impose a speed limit of 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

(3) Revoke the Royal County of Berkshire (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order 1962.

SCHEDULE

In the Parishes of Shinfield and Swallowfield

Impose a 30 m.p.h. Speed Limit on:

(1) *The Square*, from its junction with Basingstoke Road to its junction with Hyde End Road, a distance of approximately 275 metres.

(2) *Clares Green Road*, from its junction with Basingstoke Road East then south to its junction with Hyde End Road for a distance of approximately 880 metres.

(3) *Croft Road*, from its junction with Clares Green Road, East for a distance of approximately 106 metres.

(4) *Appletree Lane*, from its junction with Clares Green Road, south for a distance of approximately 40 metres.

(5) *Appletree Lane*, from its junction with Hyde End Road, north for a distance of approximately 38 metres.

Impose a 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit on:

(1) *Basingstoke Road*, Shinfield, from a point 40 metres south of its junction with the Swallowfield by-pass/Mere oak Lane Roundabout, south for a distance of approximately 2185 metres.

(2) *Church Lane*, from its junction with Basingstoke Road, east for a distance of approximately 265 metres.

(3) *Grazeley Road*, from its junction with Basingstoke Road, west for a distance of approximately 530 metres.

(4) *Beech Hill Road*, from its junction with Basingstoke Road south-west for a distance of approximately 220 metres.

Royal County of Berkshire (Bartholomew Street, Newbury) (Experimental Traffic Regulation) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council have made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, the effect of which is to:

(a) designate the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice as a Bus Lane for the use of Public Service Vehicles only,

(b) temporarily suspend for the duration of the Order the Borough of Newbury (Bartholomew Street) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1967 in so far as it relates to the west side of Bartholomew Street, between a point approximately 40 metres south of West Mills, southwards for a distance of 45 metres.

An exemption for the loading and unloading of goods, other than during the hours of 8.15 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. and 6 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive, together with other exemptions, are included in the Order, copies of which together with the relevant map can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of the Newbury District Council and at the County Secretary's Department at the address given below.

The Order will come into operation on 15th June 1981 and will remain in operation for a period of 6 months unless extended by the County Council for a further period.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 8th June 1981 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
