

FIRST SCHEDULE

No Waiting at Any Time

North Quay (Unclassified), from its junction with *West Quay* for a distance of 230 yards in a north-easterly direction.

SECOND SCHEDULE

No Waiting 1st May to 30th September

1. *Glynn Road* (Unclassified), from its junction with *Dennis Road* for a distance of 15 yards in a south-westerly direction.

2. *Treverbyn Road* (Unclassified), from its junction with *Dennis Road* for a distance of 15 yards in a south-easterly direction.

THIRD SCHEDULE

No Waiting 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily (1st May to 30th September)

Tregirls Lane (Unclassified), western side, between points 115 yards and 206 yards north of its junction with *Church Street*.

FOURTH SCHEDULE

1 hour in 4 hours Limited Waiting (1st October to 31st March)

Market Street (Square) (A389), western side, between points 12 yards north and 15 yards south of its junction with *The Strand*.

CORNWALL COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Cornwall (Padstow) (Restrictions on Driving) Order 1979

Notice is hereby given that on 8th June 1981 the Council made the above Order (operative from 15th June 1981) to prohibit any motor vehicle from being driven in the roads at Padstow specified in the Schedule.

Exceptions are provided in the Order in connection with access to premises; to enable postal packets to be delivered or collected; in connection with statutory powers or duties, agriculture or forestry, building operations and the maintenance or improvement of the length of road or of the services therein.

1. *High Street* (Unclassified), between its junctions with *Trigirls Lane* and *Fentonluna Lane/Cross Street*.

3. *West Quay* (Unclassified), between its junctions with *Market Strand* and *Mill Square/North Quay*.
