The District Council of Kennet (Ludgershall, Marlborough and Pewsey) Off-Street Parking Places Order 1981

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of Kennet, on 29th May 1981, made an Order under section 31 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which is to control the use of the car parks set out in the Schedule below as follows:

- (1) the parking places shall not be used for
 - (a) sleeping or camping;
 - (b) eating or cooking;
 - (c) the sale of any article;
 - (d) washing any vehicle;
 - (e) servicing or repairing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to leave the parking place;
- (2) the imposition of a mitigated penalty of £6 for contraventions of the Order; and
- (3) the classes of vehicles permitted to use the car parks and the days and hours of operation will be as set out in the Schedule.

The Order specifies all the conditions under which the parking places may be used and a copy may be inspected at The Cedars, Bath Road, Devizes, Wiltshire, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m., Mondays to Fridays.

The Order will come into effect on 15th June 1981.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Act or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it is not being complied with in relation to the Order you may, within 6 weeks from 15th June 1981, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Lancashire County Council (Bury Lane, Withnell, Chorley Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Lancashire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles, at any time, on that length of the east side of Bury Lane, Withnell, from its junction with Pleasant View northwards for a distance of 30 metres (33 yards).

The Order will contain exemptions to allow vehicles to wait for as long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle, to enable persons to board or alight or, to enable it to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition and the maintenance of essential services.

A copy of the draft Order, plan and statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the offices of the Chorley Borough Council, Town Hall, Chorley, and at Christ Church Precinct, County Hall, Preston, during normal office hours until 10th July 1981.

MERTON LONDON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The London Borough of Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 7) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Merton, pursuant to arrangements made with the Greater London Council, on 8th June 1981 made the above-mentioned Order under the powers of the Greater London Council conferred by sections 6 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by the Transport Act 1968 and the Road Traffic Act 1974.

2. The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977 so that in Cannon Hill Lane, on the north-west side between a point 18.29 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Martin Way and a point opposite the north-eastern boundary of No. 154 Cannon Hill Lane:

- (a) waiting of vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) will be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place will be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- (c) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle will be prohibited, except on a Sunday, unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Merton Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;
- (d) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, will be prohibited.

3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2(a) and (b) above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g. the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" will apply.

4. A copy of the Order which will come into operation on 29th June 1981, of the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977, and of the Orders which have amended that Order, and of the Council's statement of the reasons for proposing to make the Order, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 12 months from that date in the Information Office, Town Hall, Wimbledon, London S.W.19.
