

(b) designate parking places on the highways specified in Schedule 4 to this notice in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period during the permitted hours without charge; and

(c) contain similar provisions to those set out in paragraphs 2(A)(iv) and (A)(v) above.

4. The restrictions imposed by the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977 will apply to any area previously designated as a parking place and not re-designated as such, as they apply in the immediate vicinity.

5. The Parking Places Order will come into operation for the purposes of the installation of parking meters and for the placing of traffic signs, etc., on 6th July 1981, and for all other purposes on 27th July 1981. The Free Parking Places Order will come into operation on 27th July 1981.

6. A copy of each of the Orders referred to in paragraphs 1, 2(A), 3(a) and 4 above (and of the Orders which have previously amended or applied those Orders) and of a map which indicates each length of road to which the Orders relate, can be inspected until the end of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made during normal office hours of Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Room B.21, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

7. Copies of the Order may be obtained from the Council's Transportation and Development Department, Room 578, Main Building, The County Hall, London SE1 7PB.

8. Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, or on the ground that any requirement thereof or of section 84A, 84B or 84C of the Act or of any regulations made under the said section 84C has not been complied with in relation to either of the Orders may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
