NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971, SECTION 210

North Wiltshire District Council (Footpath No. 14 Ashton Keynes) (No. 1) Public Path Diversion Order, 1981

Notice is hereby given that the above-named Order (hereinafter referred to as the "Order") made on 23rd June 1981 by the North Wiltshire District Council (hereinafter referred to as the "Council") is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation or to be confirmed by the Council as an unopposed Order.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, is to divert part of the public right of way known as Footpath 14, Ashton Keynes, running from Gosditch at a point 50 metres from the junction of Gosditch and the C125 Ashton Keynes-Cirencester Road in a northerly direction for 86 metres (to a point identified by the letter A on the plan attached to the Order) to a route commencing from point A proceeding in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 42 metres and then in a southerly direction for a distance of 64 metres to a point 10 metres from the junction between Gosditch and the C125 Ashton Keynes to Cirencester Road.

A copy of the Order and the map contained in it has been deposited at the offices of the Council at Monkton Park, Chippenham, and may be inspected free of charge at these premises during normal office hours.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the District Secretary of the North Wiltshire District Council, Monkton Park, Chippenham (quoting Ref. AD/DP/57), not later than 14th August 1981 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the North Wiltshire District Council, may, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, themselves confirm the order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment with the Order.

COAL ACTS

OPENCAST COAL ACT 1958

Notice is hereby given that the National Coal Board intend to submit an application entitled the Chapman's Well Application 1981 to the Secretary of State for an authorisation under section 1 of the Opencast Coal Act 1958 to work coal by opencast operations or to cause or permit coal to be worked by such operations and for an Order under section 15 of that Act suspending public rights of way. The land which the National Coal Board required to occupy in this connection and the rights of way to which the application for the Order relates and the alternative way which the National Coal Board propose to make available are described below.

A copy of the application and of the accompanying map may be seen between the hours of 1330 and 1845 on Tuesdays at the Burnhope Branch Library, Holmside Lane, Burnhope, Co. Durham, and between the hours of 1000 and 1900 on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, 1000 and 1230 on Thursdays and 0900 and 1200 on Saturdays, public holidays excepted at Annfield Plain Branch Library, North Road, Catchgate, Stanley, Co. Durham. Any objection to the application must be made in writing to the Secretary of State at Thames House South, Millbank, London SW1P 4QJ, before 5th August 1981 and should state whether it is to the grant of the authorisation or to the making of the Order suspending public rights of way and the grounds of objection.

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

698 acres (283 hectares) or thereabouts of land situated partly in the Parish of Lanchester and all in the District of Derwentside in the County of Durham. The land lies north of Burnhope Village, west of Morrow Edge Farm and includes Wheatley Hill Farm. It is bounded to the

north by Langley Moor Plantation and the Morrison Busty Washery, to the north-west by the A6076 (Stanley-Lanchester) Road and to the south-west by Edge Lane (C10).

DESCRIPTION OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

District of Derwentside

1. Bridle Road number 10 which runs from a point on the A6076 (Stanley-Lanchester) road about 230 metres north of Rose Cottage, in a generally north-easterly direction for a distance of about 610 metres to its junction with footpath number 10 at a point about 35 metres south of Langley Moor Farm.

2. Footpath number 10 which runs from the point 35 metres south of Langley Moor Farm, referred to in paragraph 1 above, in a east-south-easterly direction for a distance of about 400 metres to its junction with footpaths numbered 9 and 11 at a point about 360 metres south-west of the west end of Woodside Terrace, Quaking Houses.

3. Part of footpath number 11 which runs from the point 360 metres south-west of the west end of Woodside Terrace, Quaking Houses, referred to in paragraph 2 above, in a generally easterly direction to Newacres Road to a point about 100 metres north of New Acres Farm, being that part which extends from its commencement for a distance of about 450 metres to a point about 440 metres south-east of the west end of Woodside Terrace, Quaking Houses.

4. Part of footpath number 9 which runs from the west end of Woodside Terrace, Quaking Houses, in a south-westerly direction to its junction with footpaths numbered 10 and 11 referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3 above, being that part which extends from a point about 200 metres south-west of its commencement for a distance of about 165 metres to its termination.

Parish of Lanchester

5. Part of Bridle Road number 10 which runs from Edge Lane (C10 road) at a point about 480 metres south of Chapman's Well Farm in an east-north-easterly then north-north-westerly then each-north-easterly direction past Morrow Edge to Green Lane (C11 road) to a point about 310 metres north-east of Wheatley Hill being that part which extends from its commencement in an east-north-easterly direction for a distance of about 420 metres then in a north-north-westerly direction for a distance of about 140 metres then in an east-north-easterly direction for a distance of about 770 metres to a point about 90 metres south-west of Morrow Edge.

6. Bridle Road number 11 which runs from Bridle Road number 10 referred to in paragraph 5 above from a point about 580 metres south-east of Chapman's Well Farm in a generally south-easterly then east-north-easterly direction for a distance of about 1,330 metres to a point on Green Lane (C11) road about 240 metres east-north-east of Wheatley Hill.

7. Footpath number 61 which runs from a point on Bridle Road number 10 about 480 metres south-east of Chapman's Well Farm in a north-north-westerly direction for a distance of about 370 metres to terminate at the parish boundary at a point about 350 metres north-east of Chapman's Well Farm.

8. Footpath number 12 which runs from Edge Lane (C10 road) at a point about 480 metres south of Chapman's Well Farm in a generally south-easterly direction for a distance of about 1,000 metres, then in a southerly direction for a distance of about 170 metres to its junction with footpath number 13 at a point about 100 metres north-north-west of Burnhope Ivy Leaf Club.

9. Part of footpath number 13 which runs from Pavilion Terrace, Burnhope, at the Post Office in a generally north-westerly direction to the junction with footpath number 12 referred to in paragraph 8 above and extending to rejoin footpath number 12 at a point about 410 metres north-west of Burnhope Ivy Leaf Club being that part which extends from the first mentioned junction with footpath number 12 for a distance of about 330 metres to its termination.

10. Part of footpath number 14 which runs from footpath number 12 at a point about 270 metres north of Burnhope Ivy Leaf Club in a north-easterly direction to Green Lane (C11 road) at a point about 50 metres south of Burnhope Flatts Farm being that part which extends from its commencement in a north-easterly direction for a distance of about 365 metres to a point about 660 metres south-west of Burnhope Flatts Farm.
