NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE
TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Thames Water Authority by the Mid-Southern Water Company of Frimley Green, Camberley, Surrey, GU16 6HZ, to vary the Licence (Serial No. 28/39/30/73) to abstract underground water from four existing boreholes into the lower greensand at Oakhanger, three of which are grouped at National Grid Reference SU 764361 in the Parish of Worldham, and the fourth at National Grid Reference SU 766355 in the Parish of Selbourne, and all in the District of East Hampshire.

The variation applied for is to increase the licensed annual abstraction from the boreholes from an aggregate maximum of 365 million gallons to an aggregate maximum of 400 million gallons. The existing authorised hourly and daily quantities will remain unchanged.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE
TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Thames Water Authority by the Mid-Southern Water Company of Frimley Green, Camberley, Surrey, GU16 6HZ to vary the Licence (Serial No. 28/39/30/273) to abstract underground water from the chalk strata at Lasham from the borehole and the well and borehole at National Grid Reference SU 682412 in the Parish of Shalden and from the borehole at National Grid Reference SU 684410 in the Parish of Bentworth, all in the District of East Hampshire.

The variation applied for is to increase the licensed annual abstraction from the boreholes and the well and borehole of an aggregate maximum of 1,200 million gallons to an aggregate maximum of 1,647 million gallons, such increases to apply for a limited period of five years beginning with the date that the variation is effected. The existing authorised hourly and daily quantities will remain unchanged.
