#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Waveney District Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of Raglan Street and a length of Jacob's Street, Lowestoft.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways:

##### (1) By vehicles being used:

(a) For police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;

(b) On behalf of a statutory undertaker or the Post Office and engaged upon the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878, under, in, on, over along or across the Highway or any land adjacent to the highway;

(c) On behalf of a water authority and engaged upon the laying, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any public sewer under, in, on, over, along or across the highway or any land adjacent to the highway.

##### (2) Where the vehicle is:

(a) a bicycle,

(b) a registered disabled person's vehicle,

(c) a vehicle delivering fuel,

(d) a vehicle belonging to a resident of Jacob's Street and being used to gain access to parking or garaging/parking spaces in the curtilage of the resident's property,

(e) a furniture removal van,

(f) a vehicle being used in connection with any funeral.

#### *The London to Penzance Trunk Road (A30) (Clyst Honiton, Devon) (Prohibition of Waiting)*

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, on the London to Penzance Trunk Road (A30) at Clyst Honiton, in the District of East Devon in the County of Devon. The Order will come into force on 16th September 1981.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit waiting at any time on the south-easterly side of that length of the trunk road which extends from a point 64 metres south-west of the centre line of its junction with the unclassified road No. 93 which leads to Exeter Airport, to a point 106 metres north-east of that centre line.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, or in the service of a local authority or a water authority or for the purposes of the police, ambulance or fire services, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, maintenance of the road or services therein. Exceptions are also provided for disabled per-
