Failure to comply

with this direction will entitle the Secretaries of State and the person holding the inquiries to disregard so much of any objection as consists of such a submission.

Notice of the Issue of a Submarine Pipe-line Works Authorisation

The Secretary of State for Energy hereby gives notice that a submarine pipe-line works authorisation has been issued to Hamilton Brothers Oil and Gas Limited, whose registered office is at 19 St. James's Square, London SW1Y 4LP, for construction and use of two flowlines in the Argyll Field.

Except with the consent of the Secretary of State, the flowlines may only be used to convey crude oil and its associated hydrocarbons. The flowlines may be used by the

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holder and, with the holder's agreement and with the consent of the Secretary of State, by other persons. Hamilton Brothers Oil and Gas Limited has been appointed operator of the flowlines.
