##### THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The Swansea—Manchester Trunk Road (Improvement at  
Bryn Sadwrn Order) 198 and*

*The Swansea—Manchester Trunk Road (Improvement at  
Bryn Sadwrn Side Roads) Order 198 .*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

- (1) an Order under section 10 of the Highways Act 1980 providing that a road about 1260 metres in length which he proposes to construct at Bryn Sadwrn in the County of Powys shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into operation, and
- (2) an Order under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:
  - (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter high-ways,
  - (b) to stop up highways,
