LANGBAURGH BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Langbaugh (Alma Parade, Redcar) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1981

Notice is hereby given that on 21st December 1981, Langbaugh Borough Council acting as agents for Cleveland County Council made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The Portsmouth (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (No. 20) Order 1981
