DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT

The Bath-Lincoln Trunk Road (A46) (Brockworth, Gloucestershire) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1982.

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 1 (1), (2), (3) and (6) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 on the Bath-Evesham-Coventry-Lincoln Trunk Road (A47) at Brockworth in the Borough of Tewkesbury in the County of Gloucestershire.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting, loading and unloading at any time on the south-eastern side of that length of the Trunk Road which extends from a point 430 metres south-west of the south-westernmost point of its junction with Green Lane south-westwards for a distance of 150 metres in order to ensure the safety of traffic entering or leaving the Witcombe Lodge site.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for a person to board or alight from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, or for use by a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan illustrating the proposal and a statement of reasons, may be inspected during office hours at the offices of the Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Bearland, Gloucester.
