HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Widmerpool-Nottingham-Bawtry-Goole-Howden Trunk Road (A614) (Goole to Howden) (Detrunking) Order 198

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 10 of the Highways Act 1980, providing that a length of the Widmerpool-Nottingham-Bawtry-Goole-Howden Trunk Road (A614) which extends from its junction with the A161 at Goole to its junction with the western side of the M62 Howden Spur roundabout at Howden in the County of Humberside, a distance of approximately 3.96 kilometres (2.48 miles), shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which the Order comes into operation and shall become the responsibility of the Humberside County Council.
