

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting at anytime on the following lengths of roads at Kinsbourne Green, near Harpenden:

A1081 Luton Road, Kinsbourne Green

South-western side, from the junction with The Common to the north-eastern side of the entrance to the service road adjacent 381 Luton Road, a distance of approximately 92 metres.

North-eastern side, from a point opposite the north-western edge of the carriageway of The Common to a point opposite the entrance to the service road adjacent 381 Luton Road, a distance of approximately 100 metres.

The usual exemptions will apply to enable persons to board or alight, for goods to be loaded or unloaded, for vehicles to take in petrol, oil, water or air, for disabled drivers, and for vehicles engaged in maintenance, statutory duties or the emergency services.

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Hertfordshire County Council (A1170 High Road, Broxbourne) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Hertfordshire County Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The effect of the Order will be to limit the waiting of vehicles to 30 minutes in any one hour and not return within one hour on any day on the eastern side of High Road, Broxbourne, from a point approximately 105 metres south of the junction with St. Augustines Drive northwards to the end of the lay-by for a distance of 93 metres.

The County of Humberside (Great Grimsby Borough) (Cleethorpe Road, Grimsby) (Prohibition of Right and Left-Hand Turns and Prescribed Route) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Humberside County Council propose to make a Road Traffic Regulation Order the effect of which will be:

- (a) to prohibit vehicles from making a right turn from Cleethorpe Road (west bound carriageway) into Weelsby Street (north) or Trinity Street, and from Cleethorpe Road (east bound carriageway) into Weelsby Street (south).

HUMBERSIDE COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Humberside (Great Grimsby Borough) (Cleethorpe Road, Grimsby) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1982.

Notice is hereby given that the Humberside County Council propose to make a Road Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which will be:

- (a) to prohibit vehicles waiting, loading or unloading at any time in part of Cleethorpe Road, south side;
- (b) to prohibit vehicles waiting at any time in parts of the following streets, viz.: Cleethorpe Road, north side; Hamilton Street, north and south sides; Hilda Street, east and west sides; Rutland Street, east and west sides; Stanley Street, east and west sides and Weelsby Street South on east and west sides;
- (c) to restrict waiting between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. from Monday to Saturday inclusive in part of Hamilton Street, south side.

Exemptions for emergency services, public utilities and disabled persons' vehicles are included where appropriate.

The County of Humberside (Grimsby Borough) (Grimsby Traffic Regulation) Order 1976 is to be revoked in part.
