PASTORAL MEASURE 1968

Notice is hereby given that Her Majesty was pleased on 10th February 1982 by Order in Council to confirm the following Schemes made by the Church Commissioners for:

1. Uniting the benefices and parishes of All Saints, Burton-upon-Trent; and Christ Church, Burton-upon-Trent, and declaring redundant the parish church of Christ Church, Burton-upon-Trent, in the diocese of Lichfield.
2. Appropriating part of the churchyard of the parish church of Holy Trinity, Meir, in the diocese of Lichfield, for parochial purposes.

3. Establishing a team ministry for the area of the benefice of Shirley, St. James, in the diocese of Birmingham.

4. Amending an earlier Scheme so as to authorise the disposal of a burial ground in the parish of Bath Abbey with St. James, in the diocese of Bath and Wells, for use as a site for a private dwelling house and garden.

5. Uniting the benefices of Fillongley and Corley and establishing a group ministry for the new benefice and the benefices of Arley and Ansley, in the diocese of Coventry.

6. Re-arranging the benefices of Billesdon with Goadby and Rolleston; Hallaton with Horninghold and Allextion; and Tugby and East Norton with Skeffington, in the diocese of Leicester.

7. Declaring redundant St. Peter's Church, South Wimbledon, in the diocese of Southwark, and appropriating it and the annexed land to use by the United Church of Jesus Christ (Apostolic), for community and ancillary purposes.

8. Creating new parishes of Mosterton and Drimpton and altering the name of the parish of South Perrott with Mosterton and Chedington, in the diocese of Salisbury.

9.—(1) Uniting the benefices and parishes of all Saints, Stretford, and St. Cuthbert, Old Trafford;

(2) altering the areas of the parishes of St. Cuthbert, Old Trafford and St. Peter, Stretford; and

(3) declaring redundant the parish church of St. Cuthbert, Old Trafford, in the diocese of Manchester.

10. Transferring part of the parish of the Holy Trinity, Warrington, in the diocese of Liverpool to the parish of St. James, Latchford, in the diocese of Chester.

11. Establishing a team ministry for the area of the benefice of Newbarns and Hawcoat, in the diocese of Carlisle.

12. Uniting the benefices of Sharnbrook; and Knotting with Souldrop, in the diocese of St. Albans.

13. Uniting the benefices and parishes of St. Alban the Martyr, Acton Green; and All Saints, South Acton, in the diocese of London, and declaring redundant the parish church of All Saints, South Acton, and providing for its demolition and the disposal of its site.

14. Declaring redundant the parish church of St. George, Orcheston, in the diocese of Salisbury.
