

**RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM
THE NATIONAL LOANS FUND**

NOTICE

The Treasury in pursuance of section 5 of the National Loans Act 1968 hereby give notice that on or after 27th March 1982.

- I. Different rates of interest shall apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);
- II. The lowest rates of interest satisfying the conditions laid down in subsection (2) of the said section 5 shall be:

WELSH OFFICE

The Trunk Road (Llangollen Road, Froncysyllte) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1982

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended. The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit the waiting of any vehicle at any time on the side of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions in the proposed Order will permit waiting for the following purposes:

- picking up or setting down passengers;
- loading or unloading goods;
- building, industrial or demolition operations; and
- carrying out essential services connected with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity.

A copy of the proposed Order, a copy of the Order being revoked, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be seen during normal office hours at the offices of Glyndwr District Council, Town Hall, Llangollen.

Objections to the proposed Order should be sent to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office, Transport and Highways Group, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, not later than 19th April 1982 (quoting Ref. WR15/1/58), and stating the grounds for objection.
