SOUTHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that Southampton City Council intend to make the following Orders with the consent of Hampshire County Council and in exercise of its powers under sections 31 (1) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended.

The City of Southampton (West Quay Road Lorry Park) Order 1982.

The effect of this Order will be as follows:

- (1) To establish a daily standard charge of £25 for cars, lorries and trailers (separate from the vehicle).
- (2) Exemption from the standard charge may be obtained by lorries and trailers by purchasing from either the ticket machine or the attendant, and displaying a ticket for £2.
- (3) The maximum period of waiting will be 24 hours.
- (4) The Order also includes provisions for the regulation of vehicles within the lorry park.

The City of Southampton (West Quay Road Lorry Park) (Amendment) Order 1982.

The effect of this Order will be to change the operation of West Quay Road Lorry Park in order to continue effectively to regulate its use, once the transport cafe has been established in the lorry park. The Order will establish a charging day as the 24 hour period commencing at 0600 hours and ending at 0559 the following day and the £25 standard charge will be payable for each charging day. Exemptions from this standard charge will be as follows:

- (1) Between 0600 hours and 1359 hours Monday to Friday the following vehicles will be exempt from the charge:
 - (a) Commercial vehicles where
 - (i) the vehicle leaves the parking place before the expiration of one hour from its time of entry, or before 1400 hours whichever is the sooner; or
 - (ii) the driver of the vehicle purchases and displays a ticket for £2.
 - (b) Vehicles which display a permit issued by the City Engineer.
- (2) Between 1400 hours and 0559 hours Monday to Friday and all day Saturday, Sunday and Bank Holidays commercial vehicles may obtain exemption by purchasing and displaying a ticket for £2.
- (3) Cars will be unable to obtain exemption at any time, unless displaying a permit.

Permits will be issued for the efficient operation of the transport cafe.

Copies of the draft Orders, together with a plan showing the effect of the Orders and the statement of the Council's reasons for making the Orders may be inspected in Room 18 of my office during normal working hours.

If you wish to object to the making of the Orders you must send the grounds for your objection to me by 29th April 1982.
